

“ALLELUIA: FOR THE LORD GOD OMNIPOTENT REIGNETH!”

INTRODUCTION: (Welcome...)

- A. Read Revelations 19:1-6. (“Omnipotent”)
1. The meaning of the word “omnipotent.”  
(Greek > “pantokrator” = “almighty, or ruler of all, to hold or to have all strength.”)
  2. This word is translated “almighty” in 2 Cor. 6:18 and 9 times in the book of Revelations where it is translated only once with the word “omnipotent.”
  3. It is always used of God only!
- B. Let’s talk more about the “Lord God omnipotent who reigneth!”

GOD IS ALL-POWERFUL! (“OMNIPOTENT”):

- A. In the Creation, God clearly shows His “omnipotency!”  
(Genesis 1:1-5,69,14,20,24,26-27 – “And God said...”)
1. Read also Genesis 2:1-7,18-23; Ps. 19:1-4; Ps. 148:1-5)
  2. GOD IS ALMIGHTY!
- B. In His Judgments, God shows His “omnipotency!”
1. Noah > (Gen. 6:5-7)
  2. Sodom & Gomorrah > (Gen. 19:24-26)
  3. Plagues upon Egypt > (Ex. 4-11; Rom. 9:17)
  4. Assyria > (2 Kings 19:34-36)
  5. Read Amos 9:1-6 and comment.
- C. In His Miracles, God shows His “omnipotency!”
1. Parting of the Red Sea > (Ex. 14:8,13-14,21-30)
  2. Naaman the Leper healed > (2 Kings 5:1,10-14)
  3. God’s servants delivered from fire > (Dan. 3:25-29)
  4. Daniel & the lion > (Dan. 6:20-22)
  5. Sun & moon stood still > (Joshua 10:12-14)
- D. In His Plan of Redemption, God shows His “omnipotency!”
1. God’s “free will!” > (Rom. 9:11-26)
  2. The birth of Jesus > (Lk. 1:26-35)
  3. The death of Jesus > (Mt. 27:26-50; Heb. 2:14-15)
  4. The resurrection of Jesus > (Mt. 28:1-6; Mt. 16:18-19)
  5. The “preaching of the gospel!” > (Heb. 2:1-4; Acts 14:1-3)

E. Therefore, "Alleluia, For The Lord God Omnipotent Reigneth!" (Rev. 19:6 > "overthrow of Rome")

### CONCLUSION:

A. What does all of this mean to you & me? (2 Cor. 6:17-18)

"...I will be a FATHER unto you, and ye shall be my SONS & DAUGHTERS, saith THE LORD ALMIGHTY."

B. The "Lord God Omnipotent Who Reigneth" is our "HEAVENLY FATHER!"

1. As our "Heavenly Father", He has the "power to hear & answer our prayers!" (1 Pet. 3:12; Eph. 3:20-21)
2. As our "Heavenly Father", He has the "power to provide for our physical needs regardless of what those needs might be!" (Mt. 6:11,25-33; Phil. 4:15-18; Ex. 16)
3. As our "Heavenly Father", He has the "power to bless us with all spiritual blessings in His Son Jesus!" (Eph. 1:3)
4. As our "Heavenly Father", He has the "power to help us overcome the problems of life!" (1 Cor. 10:13; Heb. 4:16; 2 Cor. 12:7-10)
5. As our "Heavenly Father", He has the "power to raise us from the dead & give us eternal life in Heaven!" (Rom. 6:23; 1 Pet. 1:3-5)
